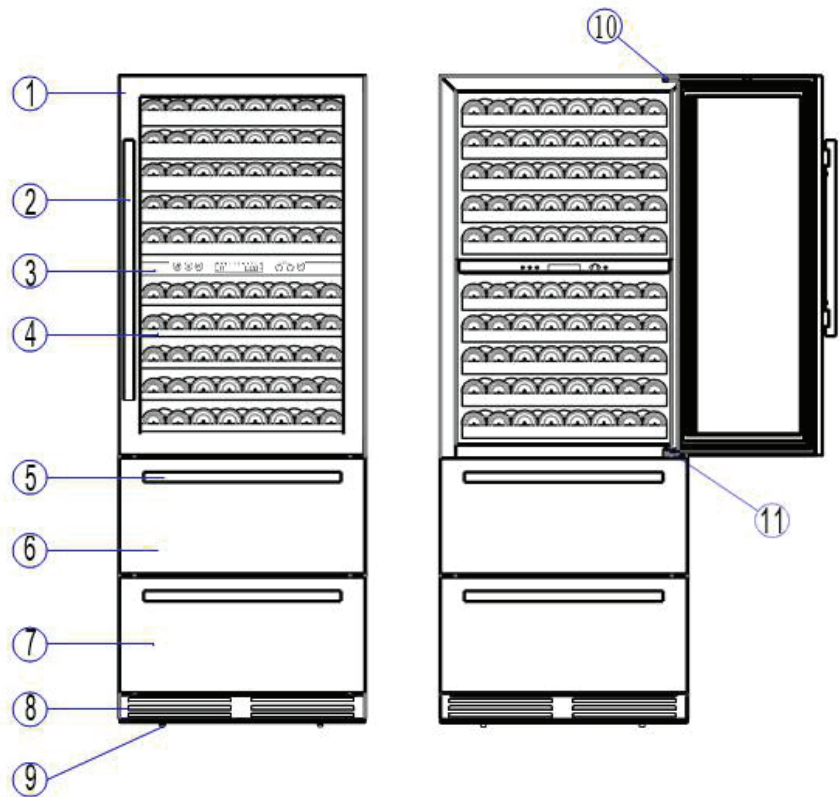

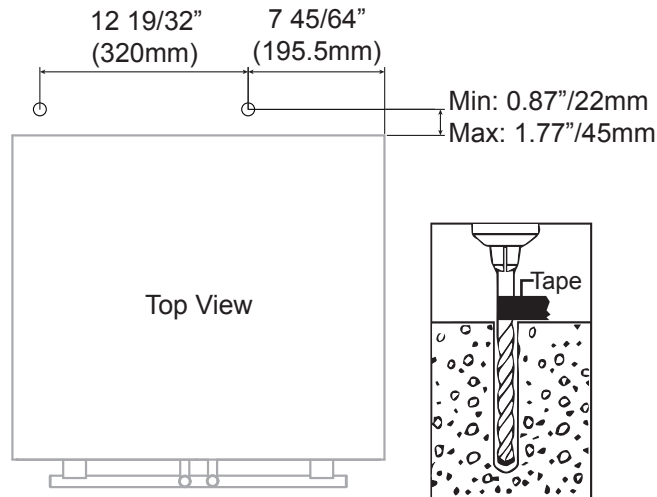

Installation

Anti-tip bracket installation

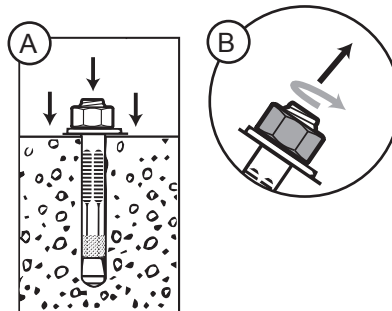
To avoid the risk of serious personal injury or damage to the appliance due to the instability of the appliance, it must be fixed to the floor with anti-tip brackets and screws (supplied). Before installing, carefully read these instructions.

1. Take the fixing brackets (2 pcs) and the expansion bolts (2 pcs) out of the instruction packet.
2. Drill holes into the floor according to the dimensions shown below. This will allow you to fix the brackets to the floor. According to the size and location, the holes on the floor should be $\varnothing 0.39$

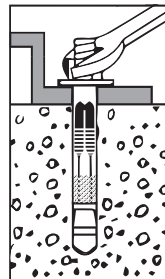


TIP: Use painter's tape to judge how deep of a hole you are drilling. First, cut a piece of painter's tape several inches long. Then, place the tape on your drill bit at the depth of the expansion bolts shield to drill. Once you reach the tape, you know when to stop drilling. Don't drill too deep

3. (A) Next insert the expansion bolt into the drilled hole. Make sure it is flush to the floor.
(B) Unscrew the nut, washer and lock ring from the screw. (10mm).

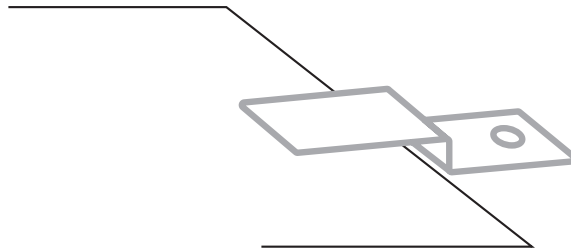


4. Next, align the bracket hole with the screw and reattach the washer and lock ring. Finally, tighten the nut with a wrench or socket to the maximum. As you tighten the shield, it will bend outwards, creating an anchor that provides extra security for your unit.



Installation (continued)

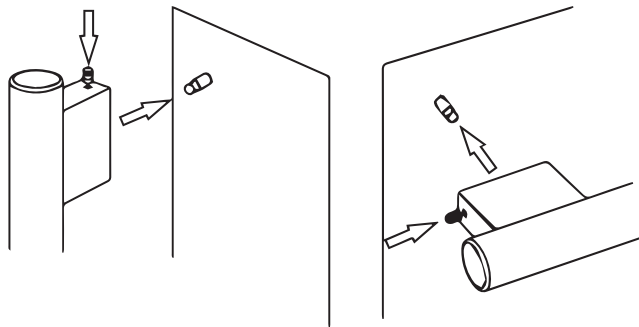
5. Push the appliance back into its place, Ensure that the bottom of the opening slides under the bracket, as shown in the example below.



If the unit is not stable, pull back the appliance and repeat the previous step until the unit is stable.
NOTE: IF THE UNIT IS RELOCATED, THE BRACKET MUST BE REMOVED AND RE-INSTALLED TO ITS NEW LOCATION.

Installing The Handle

1. Locate the handle over the pins on the door panel.
2. Fix the handle by tighten the screw.



Installation of Your Wine Cooler/Beverage cooler

- Installation: This appliance is designed for free-standing installation or built-in (fully recessed) setup. Refer to the sticker located at the back of the appliance for installation guidelines.
- Intended use: The appliance is exclusively intended for the storage of wine or beverages. Please refrain from using it for any other purpose.
- Level Surface: Ensure to place the appliance on a level surface capable of supporting its full weight, especially when fully loaded. To check for levelness, place a small ball on top and make sure it does not roll in any direction. If needed, adjust the front leveling leg located at the bottom of the Wine Cooler/Beverage Cooler.
- Avoid Direct Sunlight and Heat: Position the appliance away from direct sunlight and heat sources such as stoves, heaters, or radiators. Direct sunlight can affect the acrylic coating, and heat sources may lead to increased electrical consumption. Extremely cold ambient temperatures might also impact the unit's performance.
- Moisture Avoidance: Do not place the unit in moist areas to prevent any damage.
- Electrical Safety: Plug the Wine Cooler/Beverage Cooler into an exclusive, properly installed, and grounded wall outlet. Never cut or remove the third (ground) prong from the power cord. If you have any questions about power or grounding, consult a certified electrician or an authorized service center.

Before using Your Wine cooler

- Remove the exterior and interior packing.
- Before connecting the Wine cooler/Beverage cooler to the power source, let it stand upright for approximately 12 hours. This will reduce the possibility of a malfunction in the cooling system from handling during transportation
- Clean the interior surface with lukewarm water using a soft cloth.
- This appliance is intended to be used in household and similar applications such as
 - staff kitchen areas in shops, offices and other working environments;
 - farm houses and by clients in hotels, motels and other residential type environments
 - bed and breakfast type environments;
 - catering and similar non-retail applications
- When disposing your appliance, please choose an authorized disposal site.

Attention

- Store wine in sealed bottles,
- Do not overload the cabinet;
- Do not open the door unless necessary;
- Do not cover shelves with aluminum foil or any other shelf material which may prevent air circulation;
- Should the Wine cooler/Beverage cooler be stored without use for long periods it is suggested, after a careful cleaning, to leave the door ajar to allow air to circulate inside the cabinet in order to avoid possible formations of condensation, mold or odors













The stated loading capacity is based on the standard-size soda drink with 2.6" in diameter and 4.84" in height. (330M L)





Movable grid organizer as optional



- Right combination  button: Press  and  at the same time for 3 seconds to change the temperature display between Celsius and Fahrenheit.
- Pressing  it will show A, touch it again it will show B, again it will be show C, display window show A is the temperature of upper zone, b is the temperature of lower zone, c is the temperature of drawer zone.
- Adjust the temperature in 1 degree increments by pressing the right  and  buttons until desired temperature is reached.
- Light button  : Short press  to turn on or off, Long Press  to change the colors (White/Blue/Red) or to enter mode of White-Blue-Red running change.
- Lock button-Press  3 seconds to unlock/lock all the buttons.

Setting The Temperature Controls

- **Upper compartment:** The temperature setting can be adjusted from 5°C to 12°C / 41°F to 54°F.
- **Lower compartment:** The temperature setting can be adjusted from 12°C to 20°C / 54°F to 68°F
- **Drawer compartment:** The temperature setting can be adjusted from 2°C to 10°C / 36°F to 50°F.

Sabbath Mode: specifically, the current method is to manually press the key  3 seconds to enter and automatically exit after 42 hours, or manually press  for 3 seconds to exit; In Sabbath mode, the light is invalid, but the compressor is still running.

Attention

If the unit is unplugged, power lost, or turned off, you must wait 3 to 5 minutes before restart the unit. If it is used for the first time or not used for a long time, the temperature will be different from the set temperature and the LCD display temperature. After a period of operation, the temperature will recover.

Shelves

- To prevent damaging a door gasket, make sure to open the door all the way before pulling the shelves out of their track. Make sure the door is opened all the way.
- For easy access to the storage content, you must pull the shelves approximately 1/3 out of the track, however this unit was designed with a notch on each sides of the shelf tracks to prevent bottles from falling.

Please refer to the following direction for replace shelf with different method. If need to take out any shelf, use one hand to press down the right plastic notch as shown in Figure A and at the same time lift the left plastic notch by other hand as shown Figure B. Hold both notches and then proceed to pull out the shelf slowly. Contact our service department if assistance is needed.

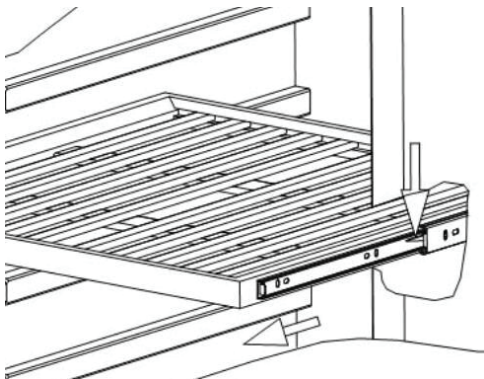

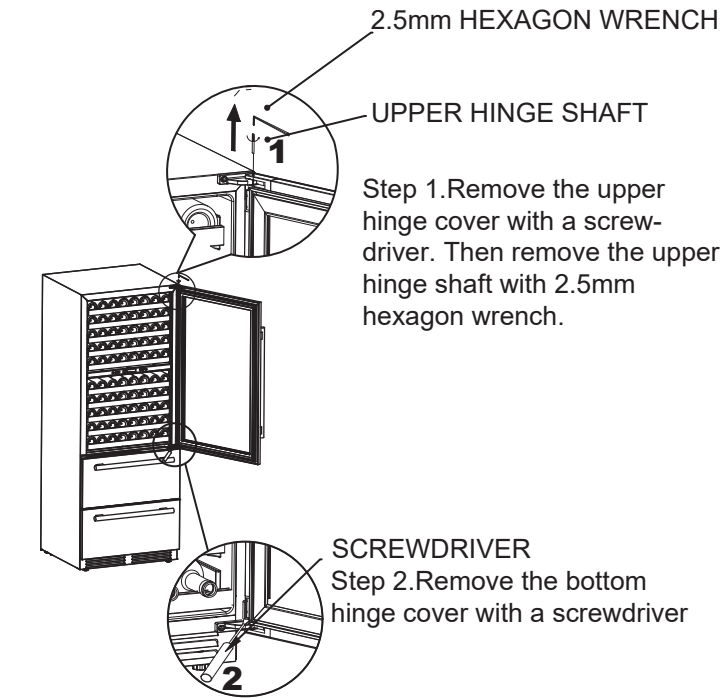
Drawer removal and installation instructions

1. Pull the drawer 100% out of the outside, if shown.
2. Find the rails left and right A and B lock card, A downward pressure, B upward, press and hold while pulling the drawer out, you can remove
3. Installation method: re-installation of direct drawer inner track corresponding to the installation of the outer slot of the box guide to push inward, pay attention to the certain parallel can be installed to complete

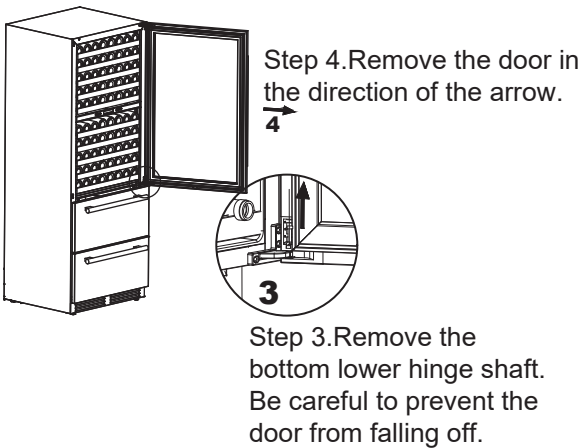
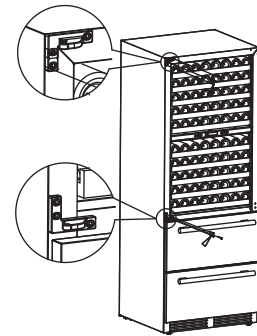


Reverse the door with hidden hinge

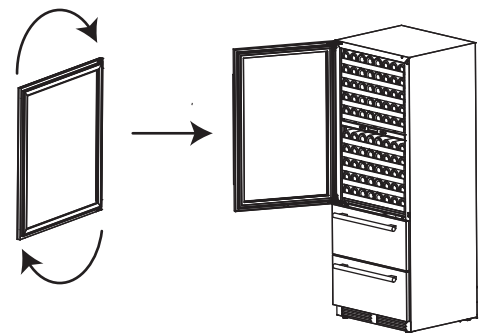
This appliance has the capability of the door opening from either the left or right side. The unit is delivered to you with the door opening from the left side. If you want to reverse the opening direction, please follow the below instruction.



Step 7. Tighten screws with 4mm Hexagon wrench in turn.



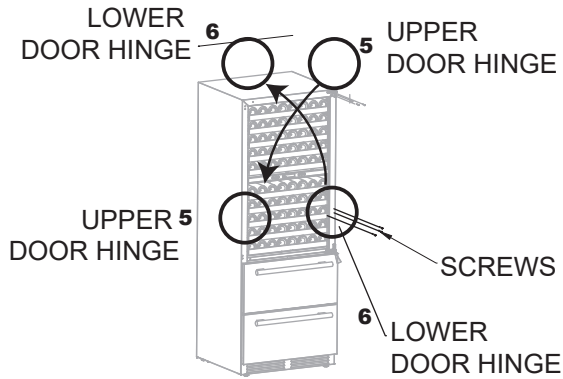
Step 8. Rotating door 180° and Install the door in place.



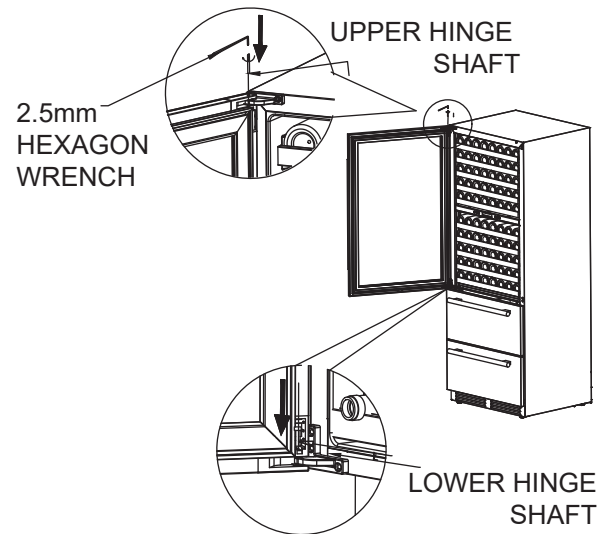

Step 5. Remove the upper and lower door hinges with 4mm Hexagon wrench.

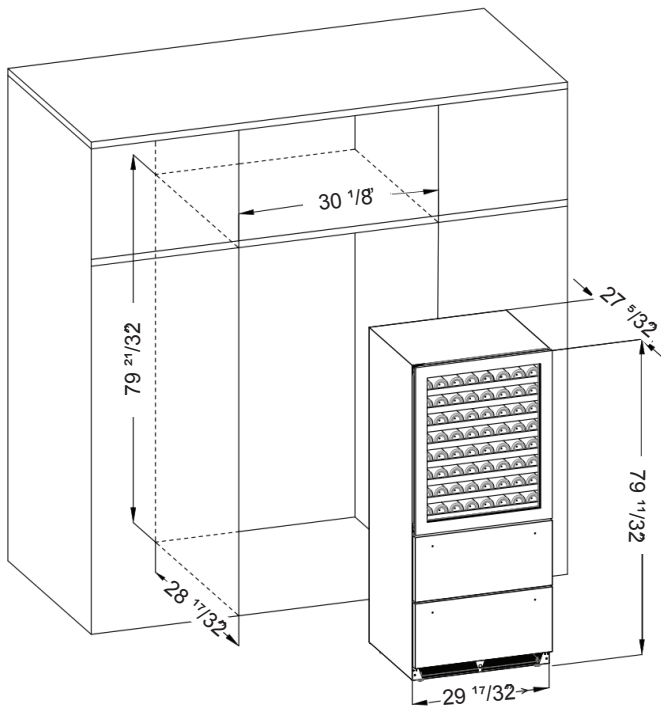
Step 6. Install the upper and lower door hinges in the opposite position on the other side. Figure 5 AND 6 .



Step 9. Install the upper hinge and tighten it with 2.5mm hexagon wrench. Then install the lower hinge shaft and cover the door shaft cover.

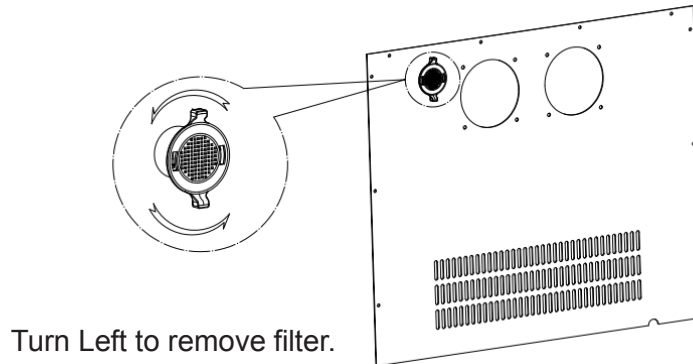
Charcoal Filtration system:

Your wine is a living object that breathes through the cork of its bottle. In order to preserve the quality and taste of your fine wines, they must be stored at the ideal temperature and ambient conditions. Your cellar is equipped with an active charcoal filtration system to ensure air purity, cooling efficiency, and to maintain an odor free cabinet for the storage of your fine wines. The filter assembly is located at the rear panel inside your cellar. Keep in mind, that this filter must be changed every 12 months.

Operating Instruction (continued)

To replace your filter

1	Remove the bottles of wine stored on the two (2) shelves in front of the filter.
2	Remove the shelves and set aside to be replaced once you have changed the filter.
3	Hold the filter and turn it at 45 degrees in the counter
4	Remove the existing filter and replace with a new one.
5	Put the new filter into the hole and then turn the filter at 45 degrees in clockwise direction.



Care and Maintenance:

- Clean your Wine Cooler/Beverage Cooler

Turn off the power, unplug the appliance, and remove all items including shelves and rack. Wash the inside surfaces with a warm water and mild solution. Wash the shelves with a mild detergent solution. Wring excess water out of the sponge or cloth when cleaning area of the controls, or any electrical parts. Wash the outside cabinet with warm water and mild liquid detergent. Rinse well and wipe dry with a clean soft cloth.

- Power failure

Most power failures are corrected within a few hours and should not affect the temperature of your appliance if you minimize the number of times the door is opened. If the power is going to be off for a long period of time, you need to take the proper steps to protect your contents.

- Vacation Time

Short vacations: Leave the Wine Cooler/Beverage Cooler operating during vacations of less than three weeks. If the appliance will not be used for several months, remove all items and turn off the appliance. Clean and dry the interior thoroughly. To prevent odor and mold growth, leave the door open slightly: blocking it open if necessary.

- Moving your Wine Cooler/Beverage Cooler:

- Remove all items.
- Take out the loose items inside the wine cooler / Beverage Cooler (such as shelf), or fix the loose items with the foam
- Turn the adjustable leg up to the base to avoid damage.

Tape the door shut.

Be sure the appliance stays secure in the upright position during transportation. Also protect outside of appliance with a blanket or similar items.

- Energy saving tips

The Wine Cooler/Beverage Cooler should be located in the coolest area of the room, away from producing appliances, and out of the direct sunlight.

Troubleshooting

Problems with your Wine Cooler/Beverage Cooler:

You can solve many common Wine Cooler/Beverage Cooler problems easily, saving you the cost of a possible service call. Try the suggestions below to see if you solve the problem before calling the servicer.

Problem	Possible Cause	REMEDY
Wine Cooler/Beverage Cooler does not operate	No plugged in. The appliance is turned off. The circuit breaker tripped or a blown fuse.	Connect the appliance. Switch on the appliance. Replace the broken fuse in your fuse box or reset the breaker. Make sure the outlet has sufficient amperage.
Wine Cooler / Beverage Cooler is not cold enough	Check the temperature control setting. External environment may require a higher setting. The door is opened too often. The door is not closed completely. The door gasket does not seal properly.	Check the set temperature. Set a lower temperature. Do not open door or drawers more often than necessary. Close door or drawers properly. Check the seal and clean or replace. Clean the condenser when necessary. Clear the obstructions and wipe off the dust.
Turns on and off frequently	The room temperature is hotter than normal. Overload of the cabinet The door is opened too often. The door is not closed completely. The temperature control is not set correctly. The door gasket does not seal properly.	Put the appliance in a cooler place. Leave the appliance to work for a while until the set temperature has been reached. Do not open the appliance more often than necessary. Close the door or drawer properly. Check the all gasket seals and clean or replace it.
The light does not work	Not plugged in. The circuit breaker tripped or a blown fuse. The bulb has burned out. The light button is "OFF"	Connect the appliance. Switch on circuit breaker or replace fuse. Switch on the light.
Vibrations	Check to sure that the Wine Cooler/Beverage Cooler is level.	Level the appliance with the adjustable feet.
Too much noise	The rattling noise may come form the flow of the refrigerant, which is normal. As each cycle ends, you may hear gurgling. Contraction and expansion of the inside walls may cause popping and crackling noises.	
	The Wine Cooler/Beverage Cooler is not level.	Check to make sure that the refrigerator is level, and that it is not in contact with another appliance or furniture.
The door will not close properly	The Wine Cooler/Beverage Cooler is not level. The door was reversed and not properly installed. The gasket is dirty. The shelves are out of position.	Level the appliance with the adjustable feet. Clean the drawer gaskets. Check the racks and bins and refit correctly.

Before disposal of the appliance.

1. Disconnect the main plug from the main socket.
2. Cut off the main cable and discard it.

Warranty

What this limited warranty covers:

The Warranty coverage provided by Forno Appliances in this statement applies exclusively to the original Forno appliance ("Product") sold to the consumer ("Purchaser") by an authorized Forno dealer/distributor/retailer, purchased and installed in the United States or Canada, and which has always remained within the original country of purchase (the United States or Canada). Warranty coverage is activated on the date of the Product's original retail purchase and has a duration of two (2) years.

Warranty coverage is non-transferable. In the event of replacement of parts or of the entire product, the replacement Product (or parts) shall assume the remaining original Warranty activated with the original retail purchase document. This Warranty shall not be extended with respect to such replacement. Forno Appliances will repair or replace any component/part which fails or proves defective due to materials and/or workmanship within 2 years of the date of the original retail purchase and under conditions of ordinary residential, non-commercial use. Repair or replacement will be free of charge, including labor at standard rates and shipping expenses. Purchaser is responsible for making the Product reasonably accessible for service. Repair service must be performed by a Forno Authorized Service company during normal working hours.

Important

Retain proof of original purchase to establish warranty period. Forno's liability on any claim of any kind, with respect to the goods and/or services provided, shall in no event exceed the value of the goods or service or part thereof which has given rise to the claim.

30-Day Cosmetic Warranty

The Purchaser must inspect the product at the time of delivery. Forno warrants that the Product is free from manufacturing defects in materials and workmanship for a period of thirty (30) days from date of the original retail purchase of the Product.

This coverage includes:

- Paint blemishes
- Chips
- Macroscopic finish defects

Cosmetic warranty does NOT cover:

- Issues resulting from incorrect transport, handling and/or installation (e.g.: dents, broken, warped or deformed structures or components, cracked or otherwise damaged glass components);
- Slight color variations on painted/enamelled components;
- Differences caused by natural or artificial lighting, location or other analogous factors; > stains/corrosion/discoloration caused by external substances and/or environmental factors; > labor costs, display, floor, B-stock, out-of-box, "as is" appliances and demo units.

How to receive service

To receive warranty services, the Purchaser must contact the Forno Support department in order to determine the problem and the required service procedures. Troubleshooting with a customer service representative will be necessary before

moving forward with the service. Model number, serial number and date of original retail purchase will be requested.

Warranty Exclusions: What Is Not Covered.

- Use of the Product in any non-residential, commercial application.
- Use of the Product for anything other than its intended purpose.
- Repair services provided by anyone other than a Forno Authorized Service agency.
- Damages or repair services to correct services provided by unauthorized parties or the use of unauthorized parts.
- Installation not in accordance with local/state/city/county fire codes, electrical codes, gas codes, plumbing codes, building codes, laws or regulations.
- Defects or damage due to improper storage of the Product.
- Defects, damage or missing parts on products sold out of the original factory packaging or from displays. > Service calls or repairs to correct an incorrect installation of the Product and/or related accessories.
- Replacement of parts/service calls to connect, convert or otherwise repair the electrical wiring and/or gas line in order to properly use the product.
- Replacement of parts/service calls to provide instructions and information on the use of the Product.
- Replacement of parts/service calls to correct issues arising from the product being used in a manner other than what is normal and customary for residential use.
